Mark Harris conducted the meeting in the absence of president Wayne

- 1 Alec Brander who has volunteered to serve as our Vice president was introduced. Alec listed several organizations in which he held positions of responsibility. Welcome Alec!
- 2 Treasurer's report. Ralph reported a balance of \$5786.95 as of May 31. In spite of our rainy weather, more rounds had been played this year than last. Move by Ralph and seconded by George Chaffe that the report be accepted. Carried
- 3 Ralph is looking for a substitute treasurer from June 25 until July 10 during which time there will be four LARGA events. He needs someone to deposit the checks and pay the bills at the courses.
- 4 Ralph informed us that he will only serve as treasurer for one more year. He suggested that it would be advantageous to have a trainee for the next year to aid in a smooth transition.
- 5 Ralph noted that there was no one at Camlachie to do the sign in on May 7, but that he would look after Camlachie on July 15
- 6 Ralph emphasized the need for the sign in person to mark very clearly on the sheet if someone does not show up to play golf, by crossing out the name. Also indicate the names of the people doing the sign in and the course members who pay for their own breakfast
- 7 LARGA CUP. Jim Whitfield and Wayne Sarson will look after the Larga cup at Wardsville. June 6
- 8 Rain Days. Suggestions were made to try and solve the problems we face on rain days, but it was decided to stay with our present system and hope for better weather in the future
- 9 Closing Banquet. Mark Harris and his wife will look after banquet tickets which will be \$22.00
- 10 Contracts for 2020. Moved by Ralph Henry and seconded by Jim Whitfield that we keep the prices the same as they were for 2019. Carried. I will get the contracts to you shortly for you to present to your golf club
- 11 Golf Carts. Blaine reported complaints from golf courses that carts are being double booked. It was suggested that each foursome should designate one person to book the carts and to give the names of the men in that foursome.
- 12 Ralph reported that 96 members registered on line, which is an increase over last year
- 13 Ralph inquired about the progress of the committee to update our constitution. This is yet to be started
